- TRANSPORT:** Transport to and from the workshop is a parental responsibility. If your school is planning to provide a bus they will attach the relevant information to this letter.
- SIGNING IN ARRANGEMENTS:** Arrival time: between 8.45 - 9.15am
Parents/Carergivers will need to sign in their child/ren at the venue using a device capable of reading a QR code.
- SIGNING OUT ARRANGEMENTS:** Departure time: between 2.15 - 2.30pm
Parents will need to sign out their child/ren at the venue using a device capable of reading a QR code
- FOOD:** Students need to bring their own morning tea, lunch and a bottle of water as tuckshop facilities won't be available.
- ATTIRE:** Students need to wear their school uniform and appropriate footwear. Remember to bring a hat to wear at break times. A no hat, no play policy will be in place.
- WHAT TO BRING:** Instrument, music stand, tutor book, 2B pencil, eraser, spare reeds/oil as required. Talk to your instrumental teacher if you have difficulty providing any of the above items as they may be able to help you find a solution.
Please **CLEARLY** label ALL belongings WITH STUDENT'S NAME AND SCHOOL.



SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS: Information regarding any additional arrangements that need to be made to accommodate your child's involvement at the workshop (e.g. wheel chair access, medical action plans etc) will need to be indicated on the registration survey. Medication to be administered during the workshop must be handed to the staff member in charge of medication at the beginning of the workshop with an accompanying note that states the correct dosage and time. **Please note:** Medication cannot be given to a student without a doctor's letter and/or pharmacy label on the bottle or packet with the correct dosage written on the label.
