ATTIRE: Students need to wear their school uniform and appropriate footwear. Remember


to bring a hat to wear at break times. A no hat, no play policy will be in place.

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS:

Information regarding any additional arrangements that need to be made to accommodate your child's involvement at the workshop (e.g. wheel chair access,

medical action plans etc) will need to be indicated on the registration survey.

Medication to be administered during the workshop must be handed to the staff member in charge of medication at the beginning of the workshop with an accompanying note that states the correct dosage and time. Please note: Medication cannot be given to a student without a doctor's letter and/or pharmacy label on the

bottle or packet with the correct dosage written on the label.
